



# X-35 ONE DESIGN CLASS Guidelines for event

(World & Continental Championships)
Approved X-35 International Board Meeting 27<sup>th</sup> November 2010

## **Proposal**

The Yacht Club (s) shall sent the proposal of application for World or Continental championship to the Chairman of X-35 One Design Class throw a national class. In this proposal Y.C. shall confirm to have read and respect these guidelines.

# **Approval**

The International board of X-35 One Design Class assign the event

#### Date of event

Chairman of X-35 One Design Class and Yacht Club (s) agree on date of event. Every change of date shall be approved by Chairman.

## **Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions**

Rules according ISAF standard guide. Rule class. ISAF OSR and ISAF Regulation 22.

Official language is English. All notices may also publish in home country language. The English text will prevail.

Published by the organizers. The International One Design class and national class check and provide support.

Entry fee 500 € or equivalent maximum per yacht.

At least 3 days for Measurements in prior to start the races.

10 races, 4 days of races plus reserve day, maximum 3 races a day, 4 races shall be completed, to constitute the valid series for the assignment of the title. 1 discard when 5 races completed. The reserve day shall be used if 6 races are not completed in the first 4 days of races.

Race length approx. 75 minutes, length according with wind condition. Windward-leeward race

Registration with organizing club. Pre-registration may done via Yacht Club or event homepages. The list are published also on the homepages of ICA.

All yacht shall hold valid a valid third-party liability insurance, with a minimum cover of Euro 1.000.000,00 or equivalent, and a copy must be handed to organizers prior to the first start.

#### **Race Committee and Protest Committee**

International Jury according to ISAF class status.

Approved and experienced race officer for one design classes.

On the water jury, one judge every 12 yacht.

## **Measurer Committee and Yacht Inspection**

Class Chief Measurer and approved and experienced measurers X-35 class. One measurer every 12 yacht.

Facilities to weigh and lift yachts, dynamometer with recent certificate maximum 6 months. 2 series of X-35 templates. Holding equipment to manage templates.

Equipment check on all participants. Lifeline check and seal according OSR 3.14.2.

Sail measurement facilities.

Inspections in prior to start the races, on water and after each race.

At least 40% of yacht shall be checked on weight, on templates and sail.

All teams to hand in sailsticker list (Pre designed sheet available from class)

All yachts to hand in safety check list (Pre designed sheet available from class)

#### Crew

Crew list (Pre designed spreadsheet available from class) shall be sent to organizers at least two weeks before the event (pre list dead line). Crew list shall contain the ISAF Sailor Identity and Classification Code. Participant crew list, shall be checked at least one week before the event by ICA and shall be published on either Yacht Club, Event or class homepages and sent to ISAF. ISAF will check the status and make inquiries where necessary. Yacht Club shall ask to ISAF for a person to support the classification process and check.

Regarding the ISAF Regulation 22 (Classification Code), Crew Deadline (22.4.1) shall be the first day of measurement, Classification Protest Time Limit shall 24 hrs before the start of first race.

Weight of all crew.

### **Others**

Logistics

- The organizing club helps and inform about accommodation, transport and hoisting facilities.
- Berthing must be free during the event. All competitors shall have a dedicated berthing area, together.

 Recommended are 3 sponsored events: Opening, mid event and price giving ceremony
