

## MINUTE International X-35 Board Meeting 14<sup>th</sup> January 2012

As per agenda chapters, following decisions and actions are taken:

Point 1: Chairman report 2010 is approved. Chairman report 2011 is approved.

- Point 2: 2010/2011 annual accounts are approved.
- **Point 3**: World 2013/2014
  - **a**: World 2013 Malmö, Sweden **approved**. Malmö Sailing Club/Lommabugtens. Event will take place end of June/beginning of July.
  - **b**: World 2014 Italy **approved**.

Point 4: European Championship 2013/2014

**a**: 2013; Spain? 2014; ??

The board approved future events for X-35 AND X-41 together. Both classes share the facilities on shore, and race area. Except measuring and weighing the X-41's – the X-35 class has no extra resources for this job. Torsten will inform the X-41 class, and ask if they want to join the Worlds in 2013 in Sweden.

**Point 5**: Presentation of programme/facilities for World Championship 2012 in Badalona. The board discussed whether the spare day is supposed to be a day during the event, or the last day of the event. Three races per day is scheduled. The organizer will look for boats to be chartered by participants.

**Point 6**: Final accept by board of class rules accepted by ISAF

- **a**: Class rules only to be published on ISAF homepage. X-35.com links to ISAF page. Info to all owners.
- **b:** All appendixes are up to date according to the present class rules.
- c: Guidelines from Alberto Batacchi ??
- **Point 7:** Approval committee: ICA President, 2 board members from Northern Europe, 2 board members from the Southern Europe. (René Lokesgaard, Roberto Gradnik, Marc Girard, Teemu Kekkonen).

- **Point 8**: Clarification of class rules questions throughout year. Managed by Working committee: Miquel Colmer, Torsten Bastiansen, Chief measurer (Alberto?), and sent to ISAF for approval.
- Point 9: Class forms
  - **a:** Sail sticker: Taken care of by Working Committee.
  - **b:** Crew list: Taken care of by Working Committee.
  - c: Safety list: Taken care of by Working Committee.
  - d: Event guide: Updates to be sent to Marianne Hansen, X-Yachts.
- **Point 10**: ICA Chairman to be pointed by election for a period of two years. First election at the AGM in Spain in January 2013.
- Point 11: At the moment the class has no international measurer. Alberto Batacchi is willing to continue the work as measurer in the class. Can we find an international measurer approved by ISAF? – Candidates found by national boards?
- Point 12: Boat remeasured and approved by ORC. Prepared for Code 0 (if possible...???). Alberto to contact Nicola Seroni (ORC), to see if the cost can come down. Torsten can assist with the German ORC. IRC was not discussed.
- **Point 13**: Appeal from the board to the national classes; News and info is needed for the X-35 site. To be sent to Marianne Hansen or Tine Palmer Franch at X-Yachts.
- Point 14: International member not be increased in 2012. Annual fee: 60 €. Make a budget for 2012. Proper budget for 2013. Torsten will forward a proposal to the board.

## Point 15:

- **a:** The class will not invest in a scale until we have an international measurer associated with the class.
- **b:** 40% of the boats will still be weighed at an event, until the guide line will be changed by the board.
- **c:** Alberto will make an estimate of costs for update of vertical template (Template in South.) And a budget for making a complete set of templates to be kept in Northern Europe (at X-Yachts).
- d: Working committee: Int. measurer, 1 board member from Northern Europe, 1 board member from Southern Europe. (Alberto Batacchi, Torsten Bastiansen, Miguel Colomer). Approval committee: ICA President, 2 board members from Northern Europe, 2 board members from Southern Europe. (René Lokesgaard, Roberto Gradnik, Marc Girard, Teemu Kekkonen, and Torsten Bastiansen).
- e: Race-/event calendar from national boards to be sent to Marianne Hansen at X-Yachts not later than 1<sup>st</sup> of February 2012.
- **f:** List of helmsmen from national boards to be sent to Marianne Hansen at X-Yachts not later than 1<sup>st</sup> of February 2012.
- **g:** Suggestion regarding future dates for events; Northern Europe prefer to organize events end June or at the beginning of July. Southern Europe prefer to organize events end August or at the beginning of September.
